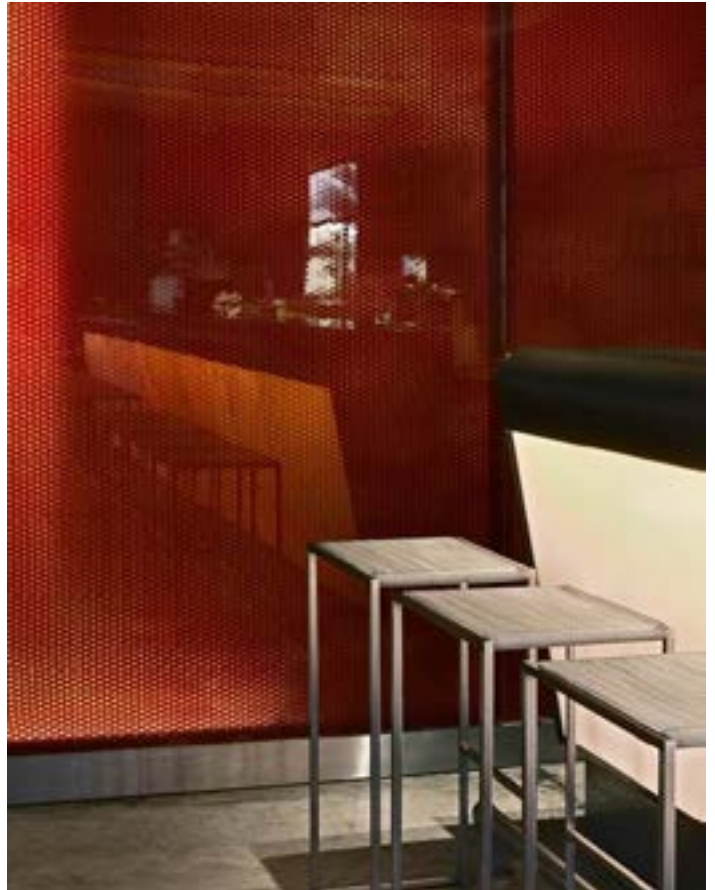
The Solution
